Dear Residents/Responsible Party,

This notification is a follow up to the text message we sent to you yesterday regarding admissions. Due to the COVID cases in the facility, the Department of Public Health notified us that we must limit admissions to the facility. This guidance is in line with our current practice as we were limiting admission.

We will be working with the Department of Public Health to reinstate admissions as we continue to mitigate the spread of infection. We are testing residents and staff every day so we can identify and isolate residents or staff quickly. We are monitoring all residents for symptoms of COVID-19. We continue to educate our staff on infection control measures, including appropriate PPE (personal protective equipment) and handwashing.

We will submit a letter to the Department of Public Health to request reinstatement of admissions when we no longer have new cases. The Department will review our infection control measures to determine that we implemented effective and sustainable infection control measures.

We will update you weekly through text or phone call during the admission freeze.
